




Gas Drilling




- Low gas prices in early and late 90's discouraged gas drilling




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
Winter 2000/01 Weather Outlook



Year 2000 Gas Storage Injections




Long Term - U.S. Natural Gas Demand




- Wide range in outlooks

North American Gas Demand Sectors




- Growth in all sectors

Gas-Fired Generating Capacity




- Major generation expansions in progress and planned

Technically Recoverable Gas Resources (EIA)




Large and adequate resource base

North America Production / Demand Outlook




- Demand profile sensitive to gas prices; alternate fuel competition
