

Discovery of Pruchoe Bay, Early Studies



- Prudhoe Bay discovery in 1968
- Gas discovered in Mackenzie
 Delta in 1971
- Gas to Lower-48 studies
 began immediately

ANGTS History




- Natural gas shortages in mid-1970's
- Alaska Natural Gas Transportation Act passed by Congress
- Canada / U.S. route selected
- Gas market conditions deteriorated

Potential LNG Project




- Proposal to build an LNG project for East Asia, 1980's
- Exxon, BP and ARCO initiated joint LNG work, 1990's
- Large volumes difficult to place in market
- Lower cost supplies for East Asia in abundance

Potential GTL Project



- Recent proposals for Gas-to-Liquids conversion
- Gas transformed into high quality liquids
- Liquid batched through existing TAPS

Industry has spent over \$1 Billion

Historical Lessons

- Commercially viable project will require a combination of:
 - Reduced costs
 - Favorable market conditions
 - Improvements in fiscal terms and fiscal certainty
- Permitting process may have significant impact on project timeline
