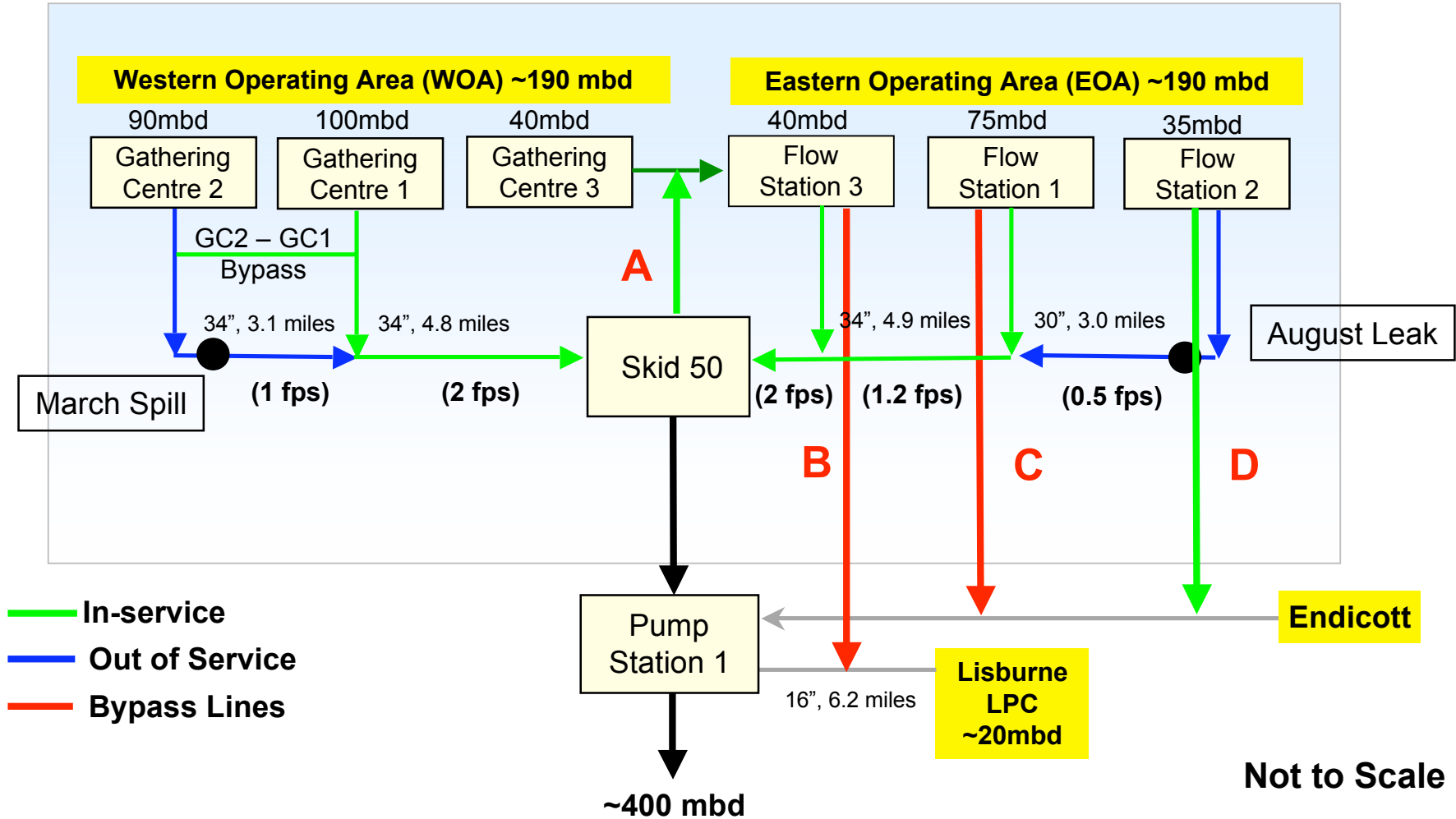

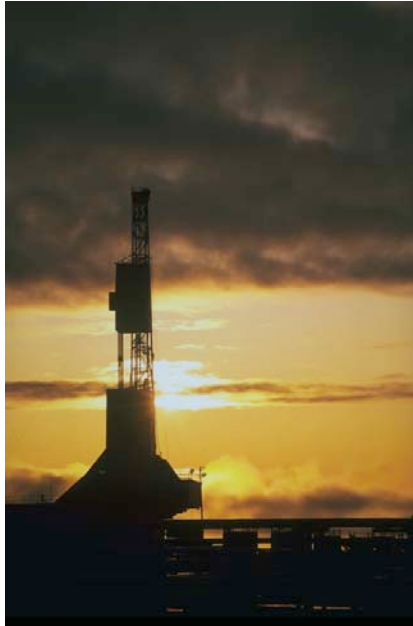


- Renew the base

The Gas Pipeline – Our Cornerstone

Several "Mega Projects"

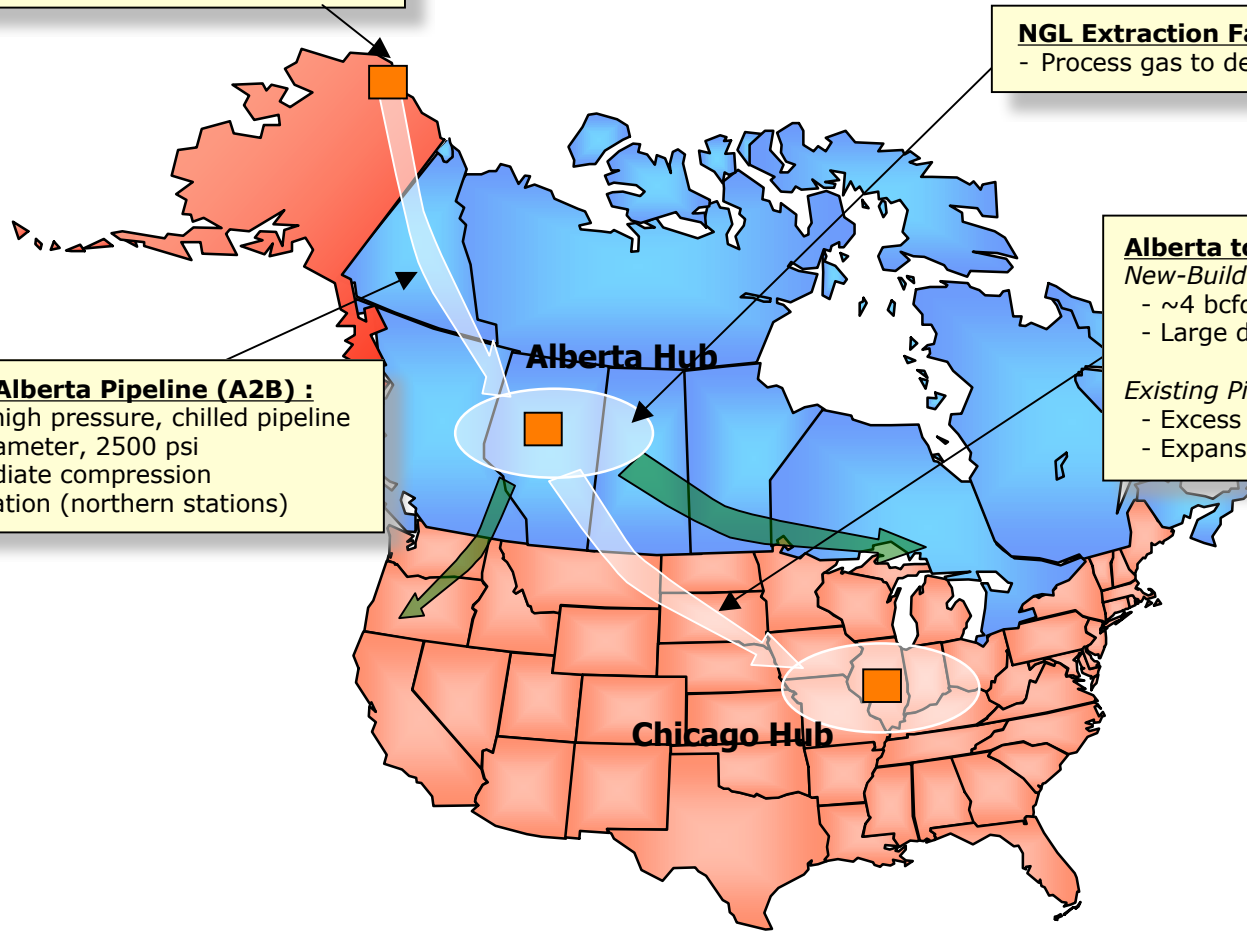
**Total Investment:
>\$20 Billion (\$2001)**

Gas Treatment Plant (Prudhoe Bay):
- ~4.5 billion cubic feet per day
- Remove CO₂, other impurities
- Chilling
- Initial compression

NGL Extraction Facility:
- Process gas to delivery spec.

Alberta to Market Pipeline (B2C) :
New-Build
- ~4 bcf/d gas delivered
- Large diameter, buried pipe
and/or
Existing Pipeline Systems
- Excess capacity
- Expansions

Alaska to Alberta Pipeline (A2B) :
- Buried, high pressure, chilled pipeline
- Large diameter, 2500 psi
- Intermediate compression
- Refrigeration (northern stations)
