



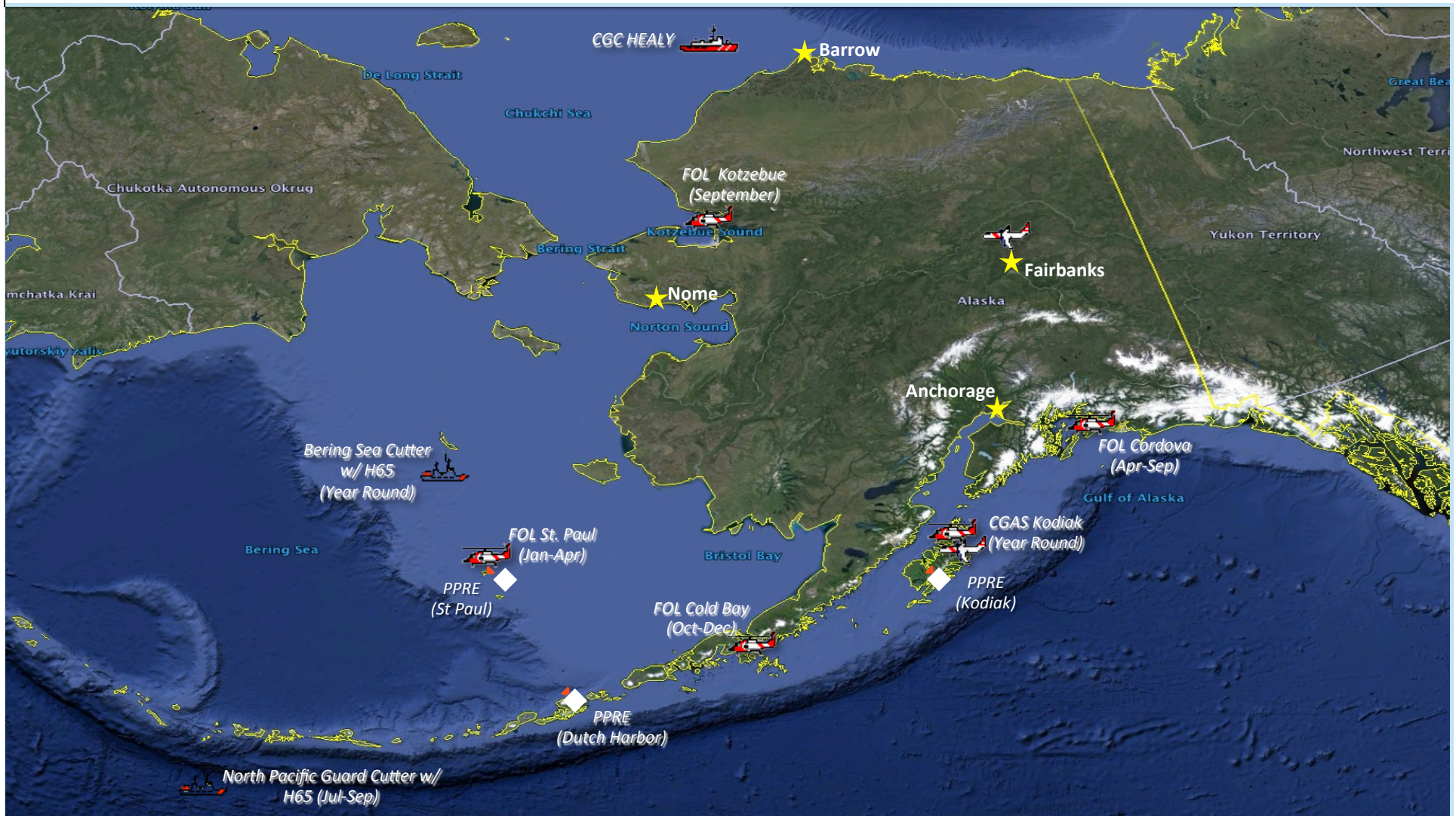

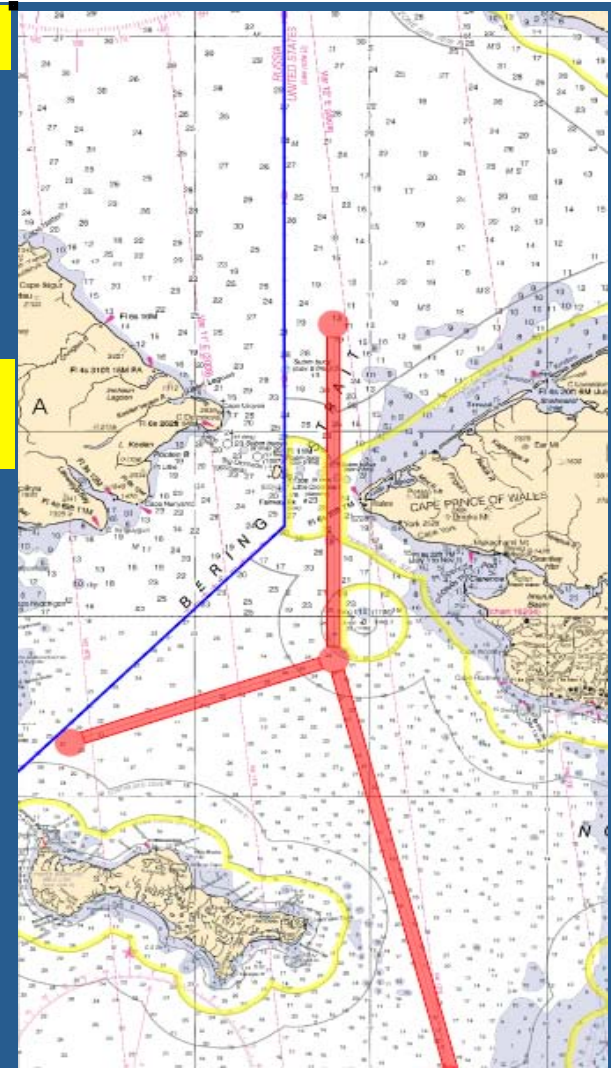
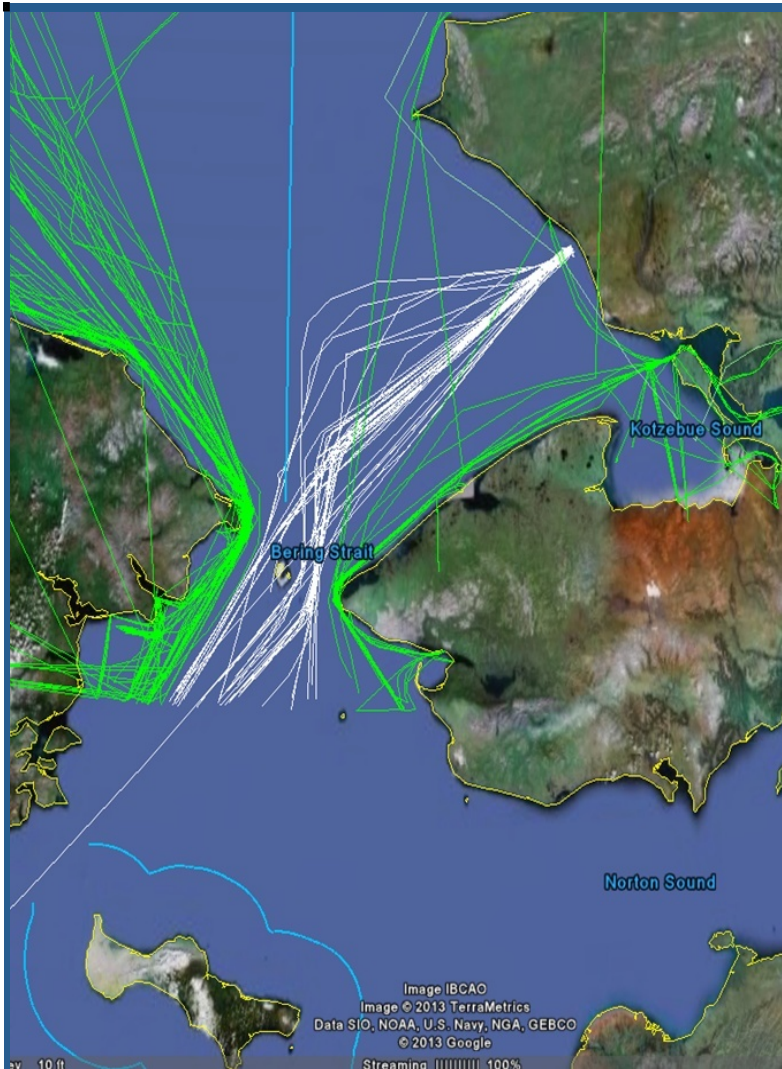


PREDICTABILITY = SAFETY

Routing measures under review:

- Four-mile wide two-way route
- Twelve-mile wide areas to be avoided
- AIS carriage requirements
- Regulatory package of Best Practices
- Speed restrictions
- Call in points
- Hydrographic Improvements
- Combining Chart, WX, Ice, & Marine Information into an “Electronic Atlas”
