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






Environmental Cases Filed in Alaska Federal Court











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Range of listed and candidate species

LOOKING AHEAD

- More "creative" campaigns/messaging




INDUSTRY STRATEGIES

- Work within the system; push when appropriate
- > Build coalitions (e.g., polar bears, CD-5)
- ➤ Be an active participant in regulatory process
- > Defend permits and reasonable regulations
- > Promote and develop good science

INDUSTRY STRATEGIES

- > Take the fight to the NGOs (e.g., Shell, 2012)
- > Think one (or two) steps ahead of NGOs
- > Education and smart messaging
- > Be persistent and stay focused on the goal
- > Think long-term
 - > Coordination and coalitions
